### **FEATURES**

Due to our moulding process, Devan Drums have a much greater material build up of the wall thickness around the corners, turning these usually vulnerable areas into the strongest parts of the drum.

In addition to this class leading strength rating ,Devan Drums feature other key features. A unique integrated handling rim close to the top of the drum is moulded in ensureing that movement of the drum is much easier to manage. There are also rolling strips raised up from the sides which allow improved control when the drum is being moved on its side. An added bonus with the rolling strips is that they prevent any product labels or warnings on the sides of the drums being scratched, damaged or removed.

### THE MATERIAL

Devan Drums are manufactured from only the highest quality polyethylene which is ideally suited to our moulding technique giving long life and trouble free service.

This material has been developed and tested in the world market place for many years with 'new generation' variants continually being developed. Polyethylene cannot rot or corrode, and is ultra violet stabilised for harsh environmental conditions. Not only do you get all the benefits of the toughest material in the world, but it is also available in a wide range of colours to suit your specific requirements. 
Perhaps the Devan Drum's greatest advantage is that our system allows for much greater versatility in meeting exact customer requirements - even on short runs.

# **SCREW-IN BUNGS**


Devan Drums have two 'easy to use' solid bungs which ensures that the contents are secure – even when dropped. These bungs utilise a buttress threaded design for extra strength.

Adaptors to BSP threads are commonly available when using conventional hand pumps etc.

## THE TOUGHEST TEST OF ALL!

The Devan Drums have been thoroughly tested in accordance with the United Nations Standard for the transportation of dangerous goods.

Devan Drums have been thoroughly tested in accordance with the United Nations Standard for the transportation of dangerous goods. This very tough and comprehensive test programme included; a drop test while frozen to minus 18 degrees centigrade, a leak proof test, an internal pressure test and a 28 day stack test at 40 degrees centigrade. As a result of these tests, Devan Drums were certified at a very high SG rating up to 1.9 and approved for packaging groups II and III.

Devan Drums are available in several standard colours. Our colour compounded polyethylene is produced specifically for rotational moulding and is formulated to ensure optimum performance in heat stability, weatherability, light fastness and colour stability.
